MEDICATIONS FOR IMPLANT/BONE GRAFT SURGERY

1.	Antibiotics: reduces post-operative infection
_	Amoxicillin (500mg): Take <u>2 tabs</u> one hour before surgery, and then continue <u>one tab</u> every 8 hours (3 times/day) until all tabs are taken
	Amoxicillin (500mg): Take <u>4 tabs</u> one hour before surgery, and then continue <u>one tab</u> every 8 hours (3 times/day) until all tabs are taken
	Augmentin (875/125mg): Take <u>1 tab</u> every 12 hours (2 times/day) starting the <u>day before</u> surgery
	Clindamycin (150mg): Take <u>2 tabs</u> one hour before surgery, and then continue <u>one tab</u> every 8 hours (3 times/day) until all tabs are taken
	Clindamycin (150mg): Take <u>2 tabs</u> one hour before surgery, and then continue <u>one tab</u> every 8 hours (3 times/day) until all tabs are taken
<i>2</i> .	Anti-Inflammatory: reduces inflammation and discomfort
	Decadron (4.0 mg): Take <u>1 tab</u> morning of surgery, then <u>1 tab</u> for 2 days in morning after surgery
	Decadron (4.0 mg): Take <u>1 tab</u> morning <u>day after</u> surgery, then <u>1 tab</u> the <u>2nd day</u> after surgery (No tabs day of surgery, will be given IV)
	Decadron (4.0 mg): Take <u>2 tabs</u> morning <u>day before</u> surgery, then <u>1 tab</u> for 2 days starting day after surgery (No tabs day of surgery, will be given IV)
<i>3</i> .	Anti-Microbial Mouthrinse: mouthrinse which heals tissue and reduces chance of infection
	Peridex (16 oz.): Rinse $\frac{1}{2}$ ounce 2 – 3 times a day starting the morning after surgery. Hold in the mouth for a minimum of 60 seconds
<i>4</i> .	Pain Medication: reduce post-operative pain and discomfort
	Vicodin: Take 1 tab every six hours for the first 24 hours after surgery, and then take 1 tab every 6 hours as needed for pain. No Driving!!!!
	Vicoprofen: Take 1 tab every six hours for the first 24 hours after surgery, and then take 1 tab every 6 hours as needed for pain. No Driving!!!!
	Ultram (50 mg): Take 1 tab every six hours for the first 24 hours after surgery, and then take 1 tab every 6 hours as needed for pain. No Driving!!!!
	Ibuprofen/Acetaminophen: Alternate Ibuprofen (400 mg) and Acetaminophen (1000 mg) every 3 hours as needed for pain.
